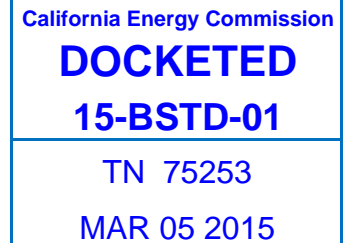

Alternative Calculation Method (ACM)

- **ACM Approval Manual**
 - Under consideration
 - Contains the process for approving software
- **ACM Reference Manuals**
 - Not being considered at this time
 - Documents how the software models building components (algorithms, assumptions)
 - Will be developed when 2016 details known



Compliance Manager

The term Compliance Manager means:

- Simulation and compliance rule implementation software
- Engine for all software, including public domain CBECC-Res and CBECC-Com

NOTE: Although Public Domain software is not an ACM, CBECC-Res and CBECC-Com follow the procedures in this manual.



2016 Overall Approach

- Combined Residential and Nonresidential into one ACM Approval Manual
- Submittal requirements
- Approval process for new software and updates
- Timelines
- Software tests moved to Appendix A and B



Types of Approval

- Functionality or Vendor Changes / no change in results
- Bug fixes / may change results
- Minor Compliance Manager updates
- Major Compliance Manager updates



Bug Fixes

- ✓ Bug fixes made to the Compliance Manager
- ✓ No Approval Required
- ✓ If combined with other changes it becomes a major or minor update
- ✓ No expiration of previous version



Changes Initiated by Vendor

- No compliance manager update involved
- No change in results / examples include:
 - Error messages
 - Screens
 - New operating system
- No approval required
- Must notify the Energy Commission



Process for Compliance Manager Changes

Minor Updates

- Have 45 days or longer to incorporate
- Old version expires in 60 days

Major Updates

- Have 90 days or longer to incorporate
- Old version expires in 90 days
- ✓ Business Meeting or Executive Director approval
(Management Decision)



Submittal Requirements

- Software tests
 - All tests required for initial approval
 - After which only affected tests required
- Software for review by the Commission capable of creating the HERS transfer file
- Fee for initial approval
- Fee may be required if an application is rejected or disapproved



Expired Approval vs. Decertified

- Included the language to cover the cases when new versions are approved and previous versions expire
- Decertification is limited to:
 - Major defects
 - Standards change

User Manual

- Energy Commission staff looking for:
