Dear CEC.

I'm writing to express my concern and disagreement with the above proposed requirement for CCT of 3000 Kelvin or less for residences in California. I don't see energy savings advantages in this requirement, nor do I think the color temperature in someone's home should be dictated. Although I use 3000K or less in most of the residences I design, it should not be a requirement. There are people who prefer, and certain tasks that are performed better under higher color temperatures. In one residence I designed, the Owner, a professional painter, wanted a higher color temperature for her art.

I respectfully request that you remove this requirement from the code.
