To whom it may concern,

Current Title-24 2013' code has had a devastating affect on my lighting retrofit business. We went from 12 full time installers down to 2 part time installers seven months ago as a direct result of the 2013 code. We don't see that changing anytime in the near future unless the current advanced lighting controls requirements are reversed. Of our active projects, they are significantly smaller in size and less comprehensive than what we were doing prior to 2013 code. Our revenue is down 60% from 1 and 2 Quarters 2014.

If changes aren't made immediately, the entire lighting retrofit industry in California will be a memory. The amount of jobs and potential kwh savings lost do to a direct result of current code is unnecessary. My hope is that the CEC will see past the negative influences of the special interest groups in the lighting arena that are pushing their own agenda, and do what is best for both the state, and the people that live in it.

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
