Notice of Availability and Opportunity for Comment on Additional Documents Relied Upon

The California Energy Commission has provided for public review a proposed update to the nonresidential lighting alteration provisions of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Standards) in the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 6, Sections 141.0(b)2I, J, K, and L. Concurrent with this, the Energy Commission identified and provided for review the documents relied upon in proposing the update. Staff has since identified an additional document relied upon, and is providing this document for public review and comment.

Additional Documents Relied Upon

In preparing the revised Express Terms, (15-Day Language), staff has identified the following document as an Additional Document Relied Upon:

Background

In February 2015, the Energy Commission published a Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) regarding these proposed revisions to the California Energy Code. In the NOPA, the Energy Commission listed April 8, 2015, as a potential adoption date for the proposed language, which was made available for public comment for 45 days as required by law. The proposed language is also known as the "45-Day Language" or "45-Day Express Terms." The NOPA also stated that:

A hearing before the full Energy Commission, for possible final adoption of the 45-Day Language Express Terms will be held on the date below [April 8, 2015]; however, if the Energy Commission decides to make substantive changes to the Express Terms through 15-Day Language, the public hearing may be continued to a later noticed date.

Staff has considered comments submitted during the 45-day public comment period and have made substantive and sufficiently related changes to the Draft Express Terms based on these comments. The Energy Commission subsequently released a revision of the Draft Express Terms for 15-day public review and comment. On June 10, 2015, the Energy Commission adopted all but the proposed update to the nonresidential lighting alteration provisions (Section 141.0(b)2I-L). In response to commenters' identified concerns related to the proposed amendments to the provisions in Section 141.0(b)2I-L and the additional documents relied upon, the Energy Commission further revised the proposed amendments for these sections and provided notice and further opportunity for public comment on July 10, 2015.

Among the documents relied upon that were released on July 10, is a Lighting Alterations Saving Analysis spreadsheet, documenting an analysis performed by staff. The document identified in this notice is a supplement to that analysis, showing some of the estimates and calculations underlying the staff analysis.
