To Whom it May Concern,

ALBD Electric & Cable disagrees with the cost analysis for the amount of time to perform an acceptance test on an occupancy sensor. The Compliance Manual suggested labor units for acceptance testing of an occupancy sensor is merely a suggestion. The factors that impact this test vary and so the time also varies. We are submitting to NLCAA our testing time averages for each of the required testing to assist NLCAA contractors.

For example, the current estimate stats that 500 occupancy sensors should cost an average of only \$10.00 each. This cost is far too low.
