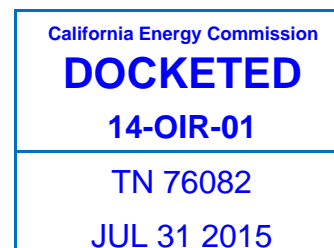
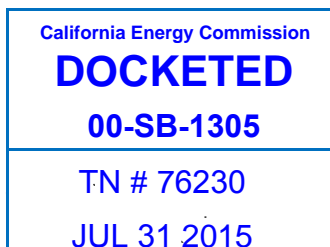

RE: Docket 14-01R-1- Application for Confidential Designation- Sonoma Clean Power's Power Source Disclosure Annual Report

Dear Ms. Emerson:

Sonoma Clean Power has submitted to the Energy Commission an application for confidentiality covering Power Source Disclosure data. The application requests confidential designation for the following data:

- PSDP Schedule 1
- Narrative Sales Information in cells B20-G20
 - Generic Purchases data in cells P33, R33;
 - Total Net Purchases in cell Q35;
- PSD Schedule 2
- Total Retail Sales information in cell Q38.
 - Total and Renewable Specific Purchases: Percent of Total Retail Sales in cells E14:E19, E21, E25;
 - Unspecified Power: Net Purchases, Pro-Rata Net Purchases based on Retail Sales and Percentage of Total Retail Sales in cells C27:E27;
 - Total Net Purchases and Pro-Rata Net Purchases based on Retail Sales in cells C29:D29
 - Total Retail Sales in cell C31.

Sonoma Clean Power requests that the data be kept confidential until December 31, 2015. Data may be released before this time if it is aggregated or anonymized such that the underlying reason for confidentiality is protected.

Under the Commission's regulations section 2505(b):

When another federal, state, regional, or local agency or state-created private entity, such as the California Independent System Operator, possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the Commission that has been designated by that agency as confidential under the Public Records Act, or the

Freedom of Information Act, the Commission, the Executive Director, or the Chief Counsel may request, and the agency shall submit the information to the Commission without an application for confidential designation. The Commission shall designate this information confidential.

Under 2505(b) the Commission will designate the items noted above as confidential until December 31, 2015. The items can be disclosed if aggregated with other data to a state wide or higher level or otherwise masked.

In the future, information submitted to the Energy Commission can be deemed confidential without the need for a new application under California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2505(a)(1)(G) and 2505(a)(4) if you file a certification under penalty of perjury that the new information is substantially similar to the information previously granted confidentiality.

Be advised that persons may petition to inspect or copy records that I have designated as confidential. The procedures and criteria for filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2506.
