Dear Mr. Spencer:

This is in response to SG2 Imperial Valley LLC's November 13, 2015, request for a deadline extension for the audit report required for the creation of retroactive renewable energy credits (RECs) in Western Renewable Energy Generation (WREGIS.) In the *RPS Eligibility Guidebook, Eighth Edition*, the Executive Director may, if good cause exists, extend a due date for the submission of a required report.

Energy Commission staff has reviewed the documentation submitted by SG2 Imperial Valley LLC, for a deadline extension for the audit report. Based on the circumstances surrounding SG2 Imperial Valley LLC's inability to obtain the required letters from all necessary parties to ensure the RECs were not used in other programs, and include the letters in the audit report due on November 17, 2015, I have determined it is appropriate to approve your request for the extension of the audit report to January 16, 2016.
