Background

Senate Bill 1565 (Bowen, Chapter 692, Statutes of 2004) added section 25324 to the Public Resources Code, which requires the Energy Commission to adopt a strategic plan for the state's electric transmission grid. The strategic plan will identify and

recommend actions required to implement investments necessary to ensure reliability, relieve congestion, and meet future growth in load and generation, including, but not limited to, renewable resources, energy efficiency, and other demand reduction measures. The Energy Commission's 2015 IEPR Scoping Order ('Scoping Order') directs the Energy Commission to prepare a Strategic Transmission Investment Plan as required by Senate Bill 1565 (Bowen, Chapter 692, Statutes of 2004). The Scoping Order also directs the Energy Commission to continue the analysis begun in the 2014 IEPR Update on using landscape-scale analysis for transmission planning. As part of the 2014 IEPR Update proceeding, on August 5, 2014, the Energy Commission held an IEPR Lead Commissioner Workshop on Integrating Environmental Information in Renewable Energy Planning Processes. That workshop discussed how environmental information has been utilized in renewable energy and transmission planning processes in the past and explored how future planning processes might use environmental information to inform energy infrastructure planning for possible future renewable energy targets beyond the 2020 timeframe. Specific recommendations relating to integrating environmental information into renewable energy planning processes are contained in Chapter 8 of the 2014 IEPR Update, available at: www.energy.ca.gov/2014publications/CEC-100-2014-001/CEC-100-2014-001/CEC-100-2014-001-CMF.pdf.

This workshop will contribute to the development of the Energy Commission's 2015 IEPR proceeding. In particular, the workshop responds to the Scoping Order direction to prepare a Strategic Transmission Investment Plan and continue the analysis begun in the 2014 IEPR Update on using landscape-scale analysis for transmission planning. Major workshop topics include:

- Landscape-scale environmental evaluations to support generation and transmission planning efforts;
- Local government perspectives on landscape-scale planning for renewable energy, land use, and conservation; and
- Agency applications of landscape-scale environmental evaluations in energy infrastructure planning processes.
