CALIFORNIA BUILDING ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS**

The California Energy Commission is considering adopting revisions to the California Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Standards), codified in Title 24, Part 1, Chapter 10, and Part 6, of the California Code of Regulations. The Standards (also known as the California Energy Code) establish minimum levels of energy efficiency for newly constructed buildings and for additions and alterations to existing buildings.

Energy Commission staff prepared an Initial Study to document the potential impacts of the proposed revisions to the Standards and has analyzed the potential environmental impacts that are likely to result if the revisions are adopted. Staff considered air emissions, water use, indoor air pollution, and changes in materials use, including mercury, lead, copper, steel, plastic, silicon, gold, aluminum, fiberglass, glass, and wood, finding the impacts in these areas to be less than significant.

In addition, staff estimates that implementing the 2019 Standards will reduce statewide annual electricity and natural gas consumption, and consequently reduce criteria air pollutant and greenhouse gas emissions. Therefore, staff's recommendation to the Energy Commission is to approve the Initial Study and adopt a Negative Declaration based on its contents.

Public Comment Period

The public comment period for this Initial Study and Proposed Negative Declaration will be from February 23, 2018, through 5:00 p.m. on March 16, 2018.
