### Background

Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. signed Executive Order B-48-18 on January 26, 2018 that boosts the use of zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs), electric vehicle charging infrastructure, and hydrogen refueling infrastructure in California. Executive Order B-48-18 implements the Governor's call for a new target of 5 million ZEVs in California by 2030 and 250,000 vehicle charging stations and 200 hydrogen refueling stations by 2025.

The activities to meet EO-B-48-18 targets will be discussed for electric vehicle charging infrastructure and hydrogen refueling infrastructure. The proposed funded activities are

\$134,000,000 for electric vehicle charging infrastructure and \$92,000,000 for hydrogen refueling infrastructure.<sup>1</sup>

## Public Comment
