

Background

On September 6, 2019, the CEC instituted a formal rulemaking to consider modifications to the Electricity Generation Source Disclosure regulations, Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 1390 et seq. These regulations implement the PSD Program and are referred to here as the PSD regulations. The Program requires electricity retail suppliers to disclose the electricity sources in their portfolios compared with the mix of electricity sources providing power to California as a whole. The Program was initially authorized by Senate Bill 1305 (Sher, Chapter 796, Statutes of 1997), and updated through subsequent legislation.

Under AB 1110, the PSD Program will also require electricity retail suppliers to disclose to customers the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions intensity of the retail supplier's electric service products and the quantity of unbundled renewable energy credits (RECs) procured in association with its electric service products. Electricity retail suppliers will disclose GHG emissions intensities on the power content label effective June 2020 for 2019 calendar year data.

This rulemaking addresses statutory requirements of AB 1110, makes revisions to clarify existing provisions, improves program operations, and streamlines reporting requirements.
