Staff Report on the Mechanical Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider 2016 Update Review for the National Energy Management Institute Committee CEC-400-2018-013

The *2016 Building Energy Efficiency Standards* (2016 Energy Standards), Section 10-103.2(d)1, requires that approved Acceptance Test Technician Certification Providers (ATTCP) submit a 2016 update report to the California Energy Commission. Adjustments to the training curricula that address adopted updates to the Energy Standards must be reported.

Energy Commission staff has evaluated the training curricula adjustments and other application amendments that the National Energy Management Institute Committee (NEMIC) submitted in its 2016 update report for compliance to Section 10-103.2(c)3 of the 2016 Energy Standards. Per Section 10-103.2(f)2 of the 2016 Energy Standards, the substantive changes in NEMIC's 2016 update report are subject to the application review and determination process specified in Section 10-103.2(e).

Section 10-103.2(e)3 of the 2016 Energy Standards requires the Energy Commission to give all interested persons a copy of staff's evaluation, and to provide an opportunity for public comment. The evaluation that reviews NEMIC's 2016 updates is available on the [Energy Commission's website](http://energy.ca.gov/title24/attcp/updates.html) at <http://energy.ca.gov/title24/attcp/updates.html>.

Oral comments will be accepted during the June 13, 2018 business meeting, when the Energy Commission will consider approving NEMIC's 2016 updates. Comments may be limited to three minutes per speaker. Any comments may become part of the public record in this proceeding.

Written comments should be submitted to the Dockets Unit by **5:00 p.m. on June 6, 2018**. Written comments will also be accepted up to and during the business meeting. However, the Energy Commission may not be able to review them before the meeting ends.

Written comments may be posted to the Energy Commission's website for the proceeding. Written and oral comments, attachments, and associated contact information (for example, your address, phone, email) become part of the viewable public record. This information may become available via Google, Yahoo, and any other search engines.
