# Staff Report Mechanical Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider 2019 Updates Review: National Energy Management Institute Committee CEC-400-2020-007

The 2019 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Energy Code) §10-103.2(d)2 requires that approved acceptance test technician certification providers (ATTCPs) submit a 2019 update report to the California Energy Commission (CEC) detailing what adjustments have been made to the training curricula to address adopted updates to the Energy Code. ATTCPs must demonstrate that their acceptance testing certification services will comply with applicable updates to the Energy Code, including the amendment process in §10-103.2(f). Amendments containing any substantive changes must be reviewed and approved under the same process as new ATTCP applications in §10-103.2(e).

CEC staff has evaluated the training curricula adjustments and other application amendments that the National Energy Management Institute Committee (NEMIC) submitted in its 2019 update report for compliance to §10-103.2(c) of the 2019 Energy Code. NEMIC's 2019 update report includes application amendments that make nonsubstantive and substantive changes. Staff has found that NEMIC's update report complies with all applicable requirements in the 2019 Energy Code. Staff recommends that the CEC approve the training curricula adjustments and other application amendments NEMIC is proposing in its 2019 update report.

Section 10-103.2(e)3 of the Energy Code requires the CEC to give all interested persons a copy of staff's evaluation and provide reasonable opportunity for public comment. As such, the CEC is posting a staff report on the review and evaluation of NEMIC's 2019 update report.
