The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop jointly with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and California Air Resources Board (CARB) to discuss draft modeling results for the Senate Bill (SB) 100 (de León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) Joint Agency Report. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public can participate and observe the workshop consistent with the direction in these Executive Orders. Instructions for remote participation via Zoom are below.

Agenda

In Session 1 of the SB 100 Draft Results Workshop, Joint Agency staff and consultants will present the SB 100 draft modeling results and updates to the SB 100 Joint Agency Report timeline. In Session 2, stakeholders will discuss the implications of the draft modeling results on various aspects of SB 100 policy development and implementation, such as, but not limited to, resource requirements, reliability, equity, workforce development, and environmental impacts.

Background

SB 100 establishes that eligible renewable energy resources and zero-carbon resources supply 100 percent of all retail sales to California end-use customers by December 31, 2045. SB 100 also requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to complete and submit a joint agency report to the Legislature evaluating the 100 percent renewable energy and zero-carbon electricity policy. The SB 100 report has been and will continue to be informed by a public process and qualitative and quantitative analyses to address the requirements and intent of the statute. The requirement is codified in Public Utilities Code § 454.53, and the full text is available at https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC§ionNum=454.53.
