Agenda

The natural gas track of the 2021 IEPR will focus on two key areas (1) situational awareness of emerging topics in natural gas system planning and (2) refinement and development of critical analytical products necessary for planning. This workshop will provide an overview of CEC research and development (R&D) efforts and staff analyses of hydraulic models.

CEC staff and gas utility representatives will present on R&D projects that support natural gas infrastructure planning efforts.

CEC staff will present its analysis of hydraulic models submitted by gas utilities and the relationship between the analyses and other work performed by the CEC as well as other relevant research as available.

Background

Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 25301(a) requires the CEC to "conduct assessments and forecasts of all aspects of energy industry supply, production, transportation, delivery and distribution, demand, and prices." These assessments and forecasts are used to develop recommendations for energy policies that conserve state resources, protect the environment, provide reliable energy, enhance the state's economy, and protect public health and safety. This workshop focuses on the infrastructure used for storing, transporting, and delivering natural gas to customers.

Public Comment

Oral comments will be accepted at the end of the workshop. Comments may be limited to three minutes or less per speaker and one person per organization. Depending on the number of

members of the public seeking to make a comment, the facilitator may adjust the total time allotted for public comment and the time allotted for each comment.
