The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to solicit feedback on light-duty electric vehicle infrastructure projects. The workshop will seek to gather stakeholder feedback on the following draft solicitation concepts:

- Electric vehicle charging to serve multi-unit dwelling residents with a focus on disadvantaged and low-income communities and affordable housing (approximately \$8.5 million).
- Electric vehicle charging that increases charging access in rural communities (approximately \$4.8 million).

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public is able to participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in these executive orders. There will be opportunities for public comment. Instructions for remote participation via Zoom are below.

## Background

Assembly Bill (AB) 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. AB 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program through January 1, 2024. The 2020 – 2023 Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan allocated \$92.7 million for light-duty electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure.
