# Notice of Staff Workshop on Appliance Efficiency Roadmap: Low-Power Mode Data Collection Procedure August 25, 2021

#### 10:00 a.m. Remote Access Only

The California Energy Commission (CEC) is considering establishing data collection procedures (DCP) for low-power mode (LPM) operation of consumer electronics and appliances. The CEC will host a workshop to present a proposal for the DCP for measuring inactive-state power and to seek comments from interested parties.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Order N-08-21 to continue to help California respond to, recover from, and mitigate the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in the executive order.

# Agenda

The workshop will include presentations on the LPM roadmap and proposed data collection procedure. A more detailed agenda and schedule will be posted to the <u>Low-Power Mode docket</u> at <u>https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=17-AAER-12</u> prior to the workshop.

# Background

The CEC is developing an energy savings roadmap for consumer electronics and appliances in their LPM or inactive state. To do so, the CEC is considering collecting data to characterize LPM power draw for a wide variety of products using a common data collection procedure.



On June 20, 2018, the CEC published a discussion document that contained preliminary instructions for product testing setup, along with a list of information needed to develop a test procedure allowing subsequent collection of data on the performance and energy use of products while in LPM.

On January 24, 2019, CEC staff presented the comments received as a result of staff's request for public comment on the *Low Power Mode Test Procedure Discussion* document.<sup>1</sup>

On February 12, 2019, the CEC published a request for additional comments for the LPM's data collection procedure.

In collaboration with the public, the CEC gathered and considered all comments received, including a DCP proposal received recently. During this workshop, a general overview of the LPM roadmap and the draft proposal for the DCP will be presented. A public comment period will be provided. Staff will evaluate stakeholder comments and proposals received related to the data collection procedure.
